Since its launch in 2004 for **NJ TRANSIT's** 25th Anniversary, *Music in Motion* has enriched the commuting experience with live performances. After a pandemic pause, we relaunched it on September 26, 2024, with a free concert by the Emmy and Grammy-winning New Jersey Symphony Orchestra at Hoboken Terminal. We continued this momentum through October with weekly performances in partnership with the Hoboken Arts Association.

- Performers must carry their own insurance to participate in the event.
- Performers must apply for a NJ TRANSIT access permit.
