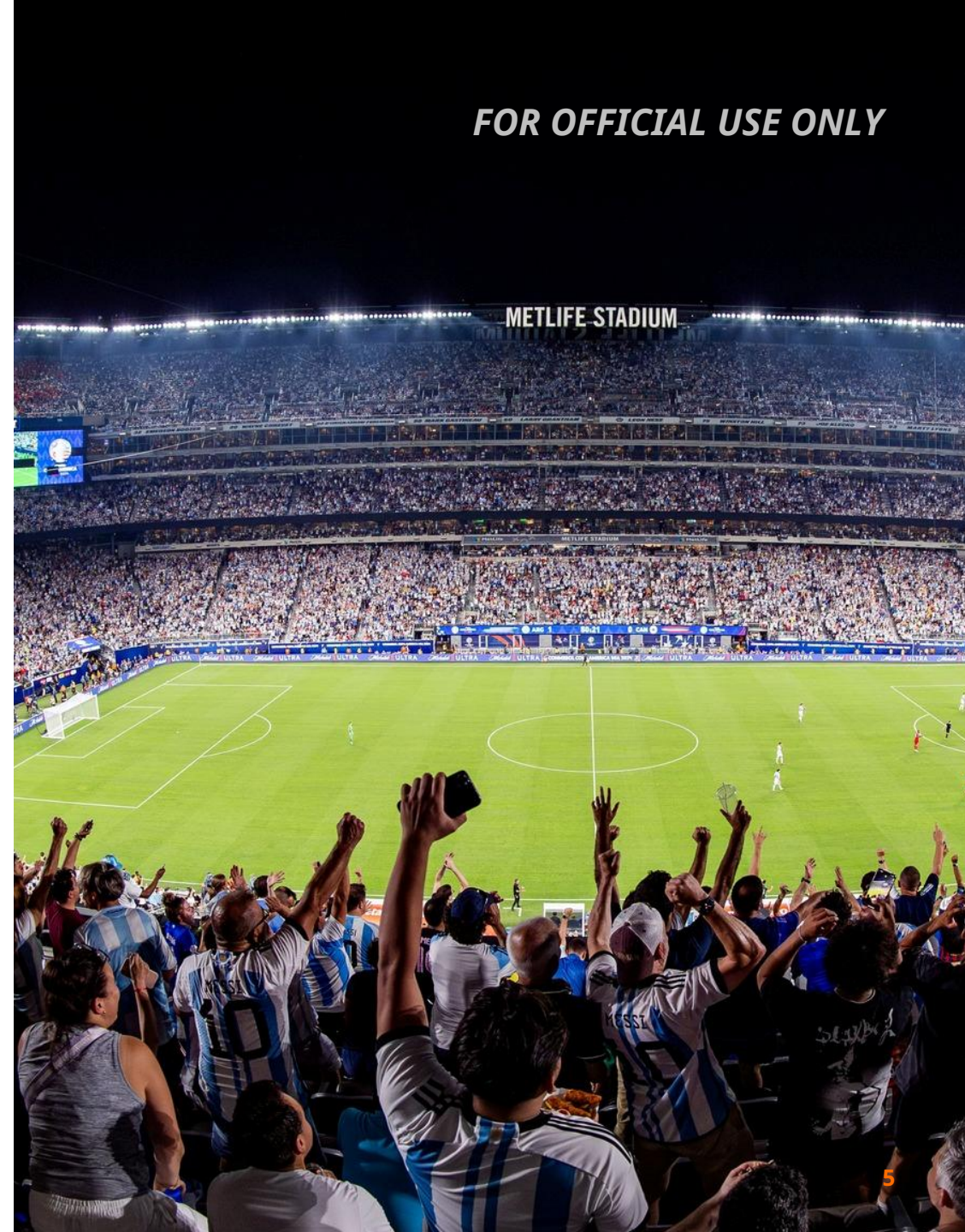

Stadium Mobility

- NYNJ will be hosting **8 matches**, including the **Final**
- The transportation for each match is designed to move more than **78,000 spectators per match**
- Due to the FIFA footprint at NYNJ Stadium (MetLife Stadium), there will be **no general spectator parking** on stadium property
- Access to the stadium will be **limited to official transportation options only**
- A **valid FIFA World Cup 2026™ match ticket will be required** to purchase and access official matchday transportation services to and from the stadium

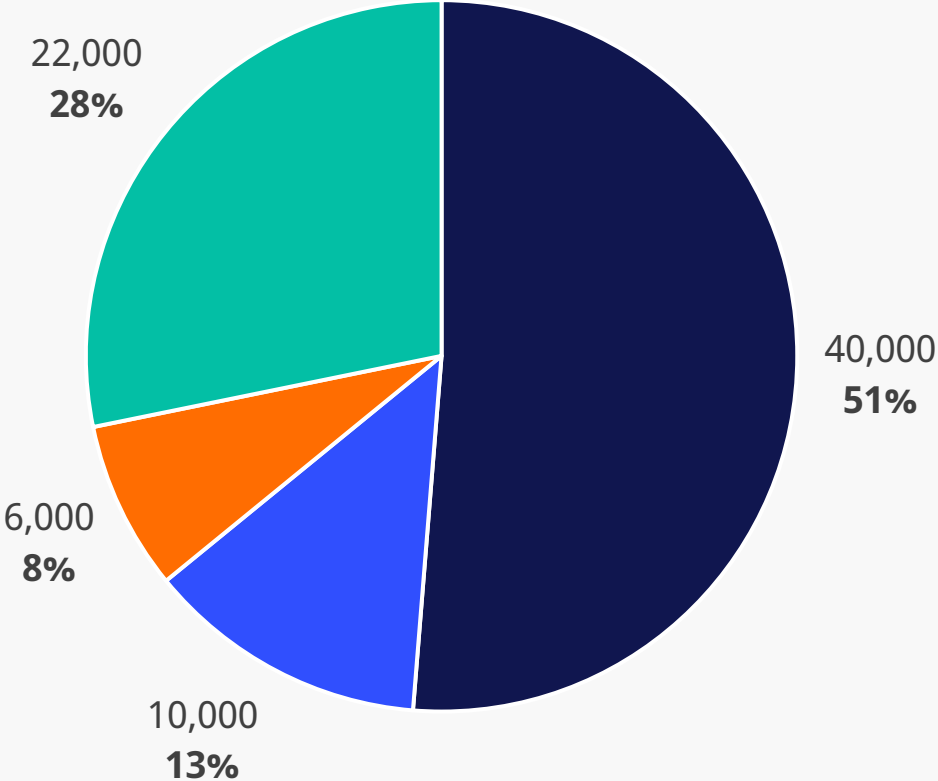

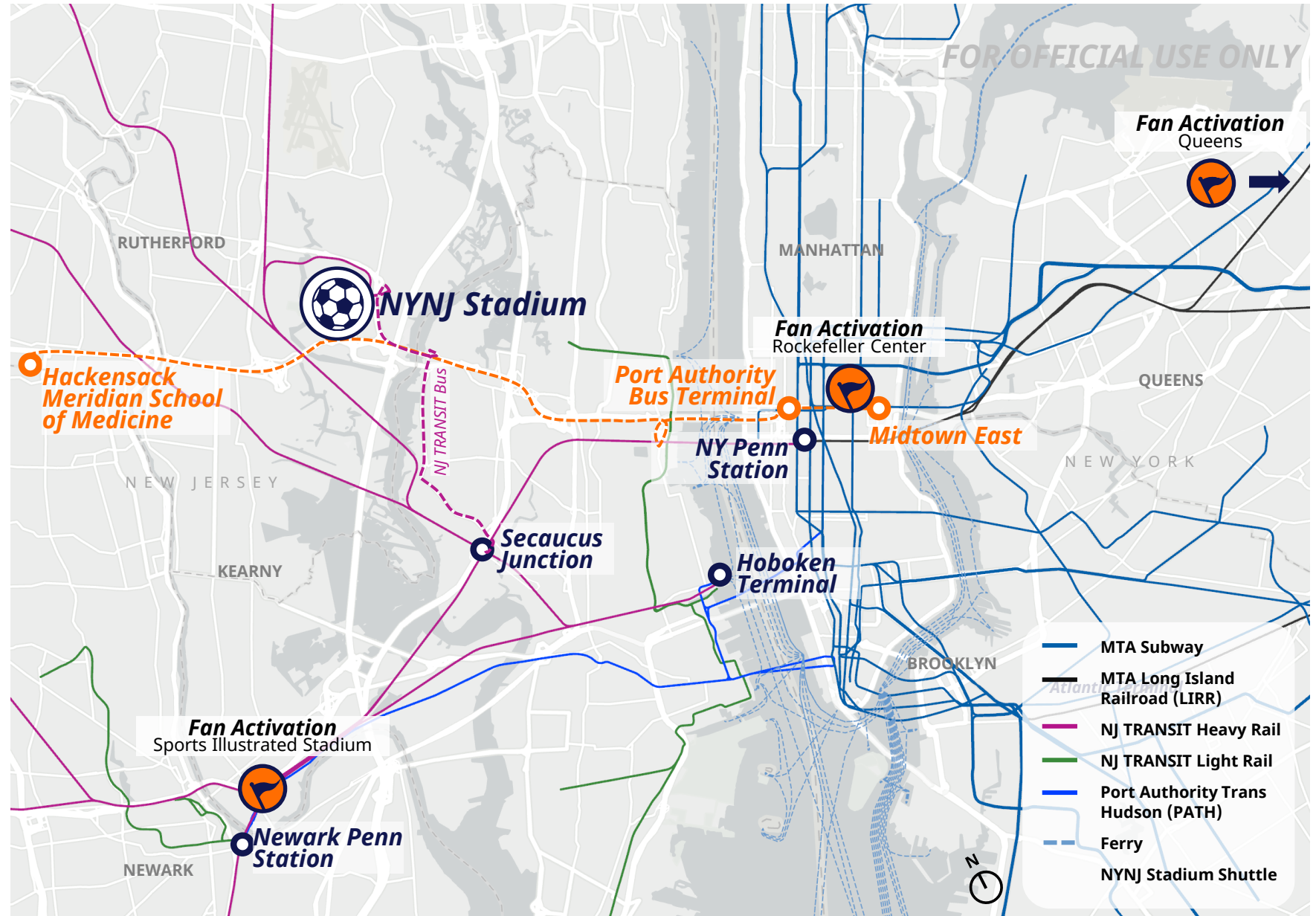

Safety and Security

FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY

COLLABORATIVE EFFORT

A Unified Command coordinates 362 partner agencies (federal/state/local, transit, utilities, EMS/hospitals, venue security) using one plan, shared communications, and clear decision lines.

MATCHDAY SECURITY

Zoned perimeters include layered screening, protected team and official routes, crowd-metered transit surges, airspace counter-UAS enforcement, real-time density and heat monitoring, on-site medical, and rehearsed shelter/evacuation playbooks.

OTHER ACTIVITY

Credentialed access at practice venues/hotels; cyber hardening and ongoing drills.

NJ TRANSIT

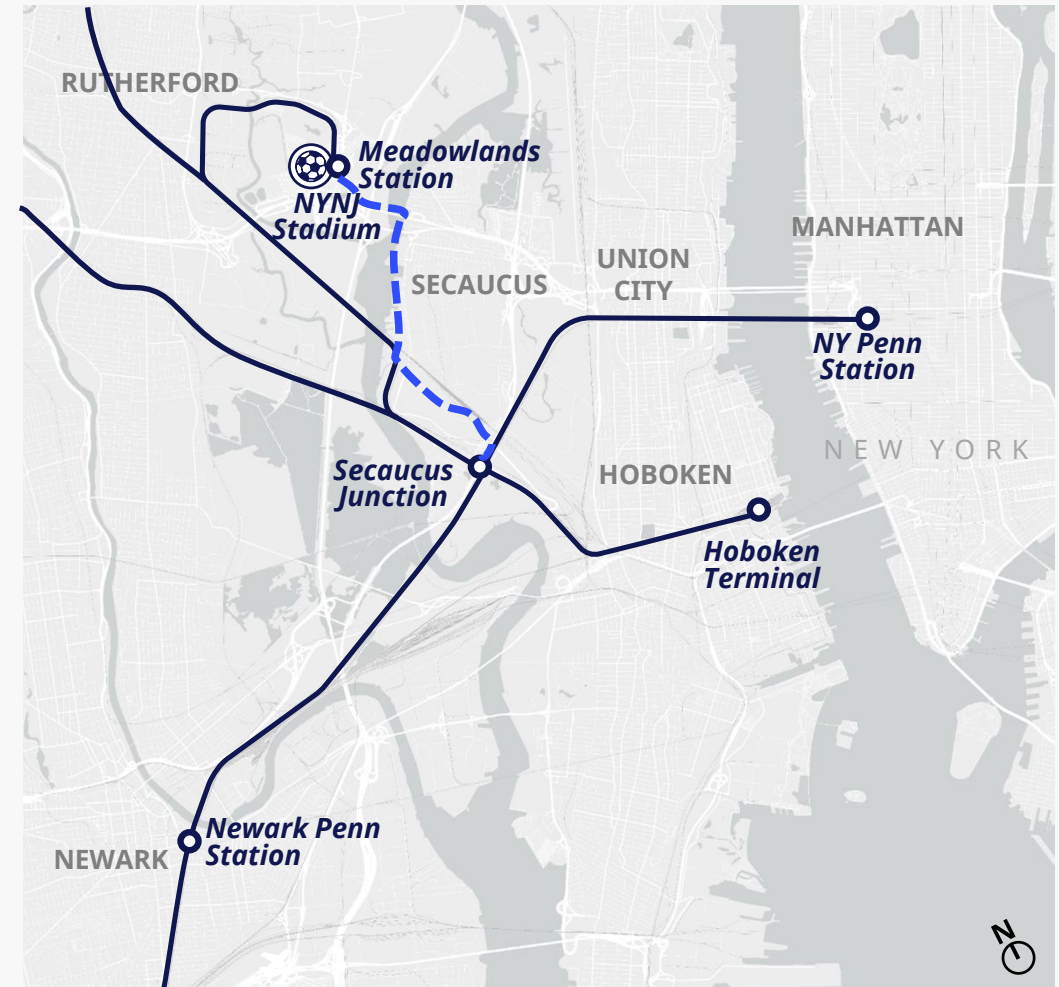
- From a public safety and capacity standpoint, NJ TRANSIT has committed to safely and efficiently moving **only up to 40,000** general spectators to and from the NYNJ Stadium
- Fans living or staying in New York City, including all five boroughs, **must** use Penn Station New York for **rail** travel to the NYNJ Stadium on matchdays
- Providing a multitude of public transportation options to our regular customers on match days, including discounts and cross honoring supported by the NYNJ Host Committee, for those who rely on NJ TRANSIT for essential travel on June 22 and June 30
- **Avoid non-essential travel and work from home to the greatest extent possible on matchdays**
- **Regular commuters will not pay for the overall cost of transportation for the eight matches.** NJ TRANSIT's cost to prepare for and operate rail/bus service and provide all necessary security and customer service is at least \$48 million for the eight matches. NJ TRANSIT will charge FIFA match ticket holders a promotional rail fare to cover the cost
- Coordinated plan and supported by all partners

NJ TRANSIT

FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY

NJ TRANSIT rail service will serve as the **primary high-capacity travel option** for spectators on matchdays.

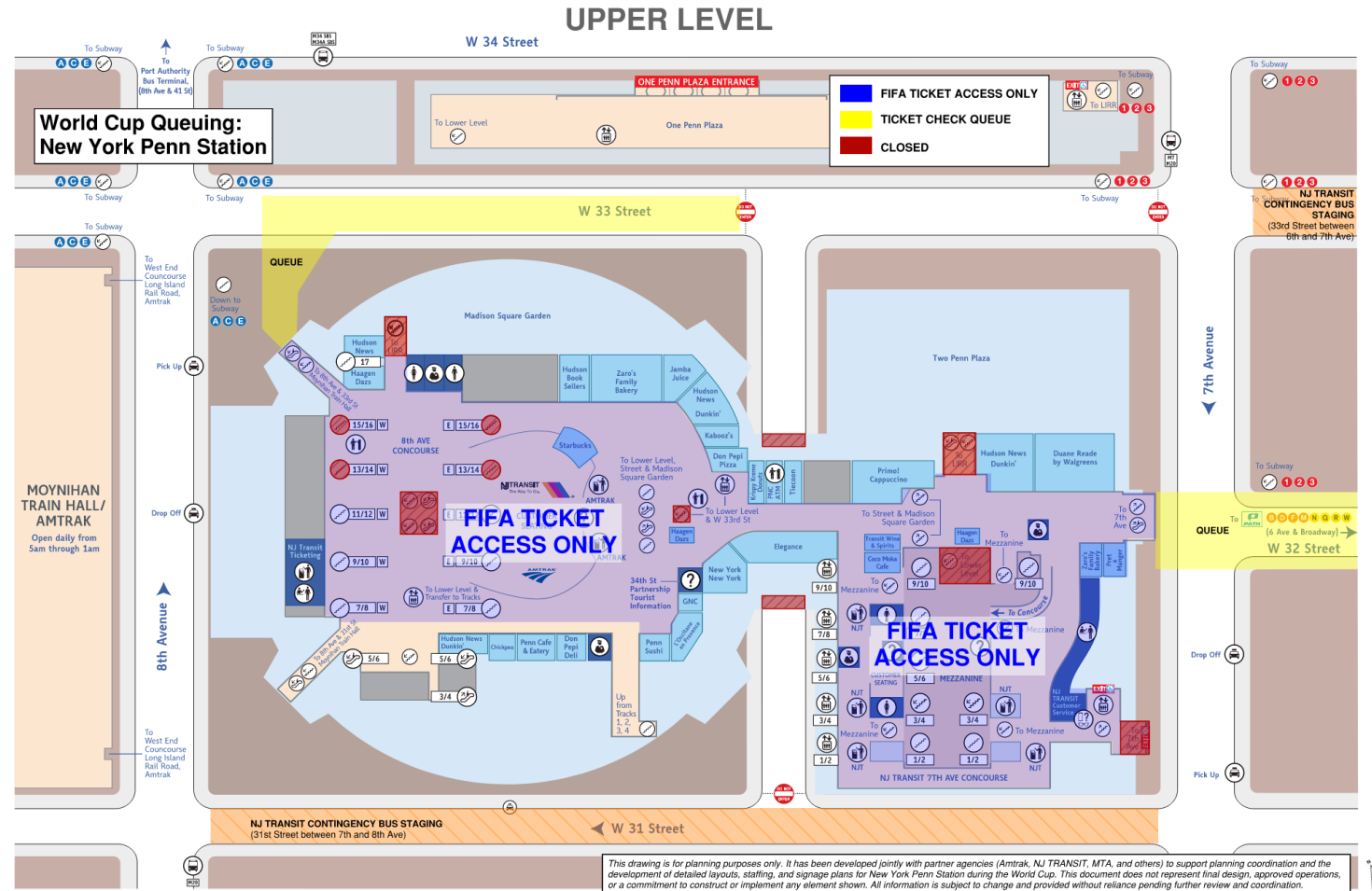
- Starting four hours before kickoff, NJ TRANSIT rail service from New York Penn Station to Secaucus Junction will be limited to FIFA World Cup 2026™ ticket holders, with tickets checked prior to boarding. All tickets must be purchased in advance.
 - Customers will still be able to travel into New York Penn Station during the four-hour pre-match window
- Fans traveling from other NJ TRANSIT stations must connect at Secaucus Junction or Hoboken Terminal to reach NYNJ Stadium.
- Upon arrival at Secaucus Junction, fans will be directed to connecting service to the Stadium.
- Following the match, all NJ TRANSIT service from NYNJ Stadium will go to Secaucus Junction for connecting train service to all NJ TRANSIT stations, including Hoboken and New York Penn Station.



NY Penn Station

FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY

- Match tickets and NJ TRANSIT tickets will be checked and validated at NY Penn Station through street-level queues on 33rd St between 7th and 8th Ave and on 32nd St between 6th and 7th Ave
- Non-FWC26 NJ TRANSIT passengers will be able to use PATH service at 33rd St and 6th Ave, or NJ TRANSIT bus service from Port Authority Bus Terminal at no additional cost
- Customers may also choose Amtrak and Ferry services
- MTA LIRR and Amtrak passengers will be able to access the station for normal service through subway entrances, the entrances on 7th Ave / 33rd St and 7th Ave / 34th St, and Moynihan Train Hall



Pre-Match: Other NJ TRANSIT Stations

FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY

- **Secaucus Junction Station** | Access to Secaucus Junction Station and NYNJ Stadium will be limited to FIFA World Cup 26™ match ticket holders beginning 4 hours prior to the match start time on matchdays. NY Penn Station will open sooner, if FIFA/NJ TRANSIT match/train ticket holders are processed and transported faster. NY Penn Station and Secaucus Junction will be accessible to regular commuters up until 4 hours prior to match start time, and again once the match starts.
- 4 hours before game time, all passengers at Secaucus Junction will be directed to connecting services to NYNJ Stadium
 - **Newark Penn Station and All Other Stations** | Ticket holders will be able to board NY-bound service that stops at Secaucus Junction, and upon disembarking the train, passengers will be directed to a ticket validation queue at Secaucus Junction before boarding NYNJ Stadium-bound service.

Post-Match: NJ TRANSIT Service

FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY

- FIFA match-goers must leave on the travel mode they arrived at NYNJ Stadium on
- Trains departing from New York Penn Station and Hoboken will operate normally
 - Trains will make normal stops at Secaucus
- All trains to New York **will terminate at either Newark Penn Station or Newark Broad Street (NBS) depending on rail line, for 3 hours after the match ends**
 - Customers will be directed to PATH for service to NY at Newark Penn Station
 - Customers at Newark Broad Street may connect to service to Hoboken for connecting PATH service to NY
 - All NJ TRANSIT tickets with a New York origin or destination will be cross-honored for travel on PATH for 3 hours after the match ends
- Expect heavy ridership from returning fans

NJ TRANSIT Regular Service and Everyday Travel

FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY

PRE-MATCH WINDOW

4 HOURS

NJ TRANSIT trains from NY Penn Station to Secaucus limited to FIFA World Cup 2026™ match ticket holders only.

Amtrak and MTA LIRR passengers directed to access NY Penn Station from 7th Ave / 33rd St and 34th St and Moynihan Train Hall.

NJ TRANSIT trains operating into NY Penn Station will be available to all customers. Stops at Secaucus Junction will be made only for FWC26 fans.

NJ TRANSIT trains operating into Hoboken Terminal will bypass Secaucus Junction.

NJ TRANSIT commuters are encouraged to consider working-from-home on matchdays, plan ahead, and adjust travel schedules, if possible.

PATH will be the main provider for NJ TRANSIT's regular commuters during the pre- and post-match windows, with a plan to increase service on all matchdays for **four hours prior to match start and **three hours** after the match ends to provide additional capacity**

MATCH TIME

1.5-2 HOURS

Limited service from NYNJ Stadium to Secaucus Junction will continue.

Service to and from NY Penn Station, Hoboken Terminal, and Newark Penn Station will operate as normal.

POST-MATCH WINDOW

UP TO 3 HOURS

NJ TRANSIT trains that normally operate into NY Penn Station will terminate at Newark Penn Station or Newark Broad Street.

NJ TRANSIT trains from NY Penn Station will be available to all customers, and passengers should expect heavy ridership from returning fans at Secaucus Junction.

What NJ TRANSIT Commuters Should Expect

FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY

Travel on matchdays should be limited to essential travel only.

Weekday travel on matchdays will look different than a typical day. NJ TRANSIT will continue to support everyday commuting with targeted service adjustments to accommodate FIFA World Cup 2026™ operations. Commuters should plan ahead and follow official NJ TRANSIT channels for updates and guidance.

- **Customers will not be burdened with the financial costs of FIFA World Cup transportation**
- **Shift travel times** where possible to avoid matchday peaks
- **A multitude of options** for NY rail customers, such as PATH and NJ TRANSIT bus service, will be available during pre- and post-match periods on matchdays
- Expect **busier** stations that will support NYNJ Stadium service on matchdays to have additional staff and security presence
- Employers are encouraged to support **flexible schedules or remote work** on matchdays where feasible
- If you must travel to and from New York Penn Station on June 22 and June 30, customers will receive discounts on one-way, weekly, monthly and FlexPass tickets for future travel

NJ TRANSIT Ticketing

FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY

- **A valid FIFA World Cup 2026™ match ticket will be required** to purchase NJ TRANSIT rail transportation and to access matchday services
- Rail tickets are non-transferable and non-refundable and will be checked prior to boarding
- NJ TRANSIT tickets must be purchased in advance and will be available for purchase **only** on the NJ TRANSIT Mobile App. **Only 40,000 rail tickets will be sold for each game.**
- Customers must select a departure time window upon purchase to help support a smooth pre-match experience
- NJ TRANSIT tickets go on sale on May 13th for \$150 per person, and **all tickets are round-trip, nontransferable, and nonrefundable.**
 - NJ TRANSIT's promotional rail fare is directly tied to the at least \$48 million cost to prepare and operate service in a safe and efficient manner during the eight games.
 - The original cost of \$62 million to operate the service was offset by \$10.7 million in federal grants, along with \$3.6 million from the NYNJ Host Committee to help pay for discounts and cross-honoring.
- Passengers must show both a valid FIFA match ticket and NJ TRANSIT ticket prior to boarding NJ TRANSIT services
- Ticketed passengers will be issued a wristband which they will need to travel to and from the Stadium, *no wristband = no ride*



Contingency Planning

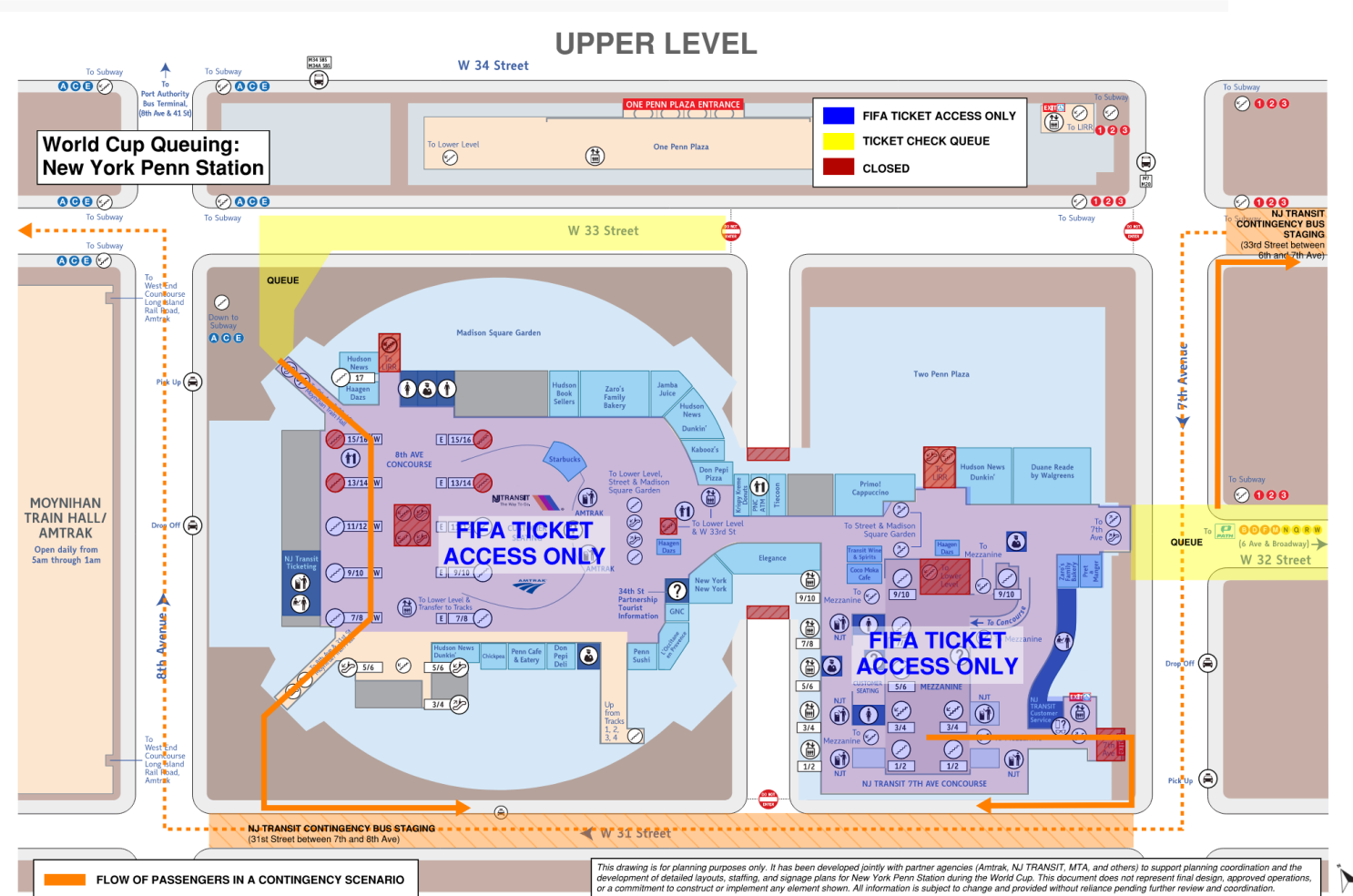

A multitude of contingency plans have been developed.

For example, if rail service is disrupted between NY Penn Station and Secaucus Junction pre-match at the largest key origin point, a bus contingency plan will be deployed:

- Buses will be pre-staged on 31st St between 7th and 8th Ave and 33rd St between 6th and 7th Ave
- Ticket checks will still be conducted as passengers are routed to the nearest bus loading zone

Additional contingency plans have been developed by NJ TRANSIT for all operations.

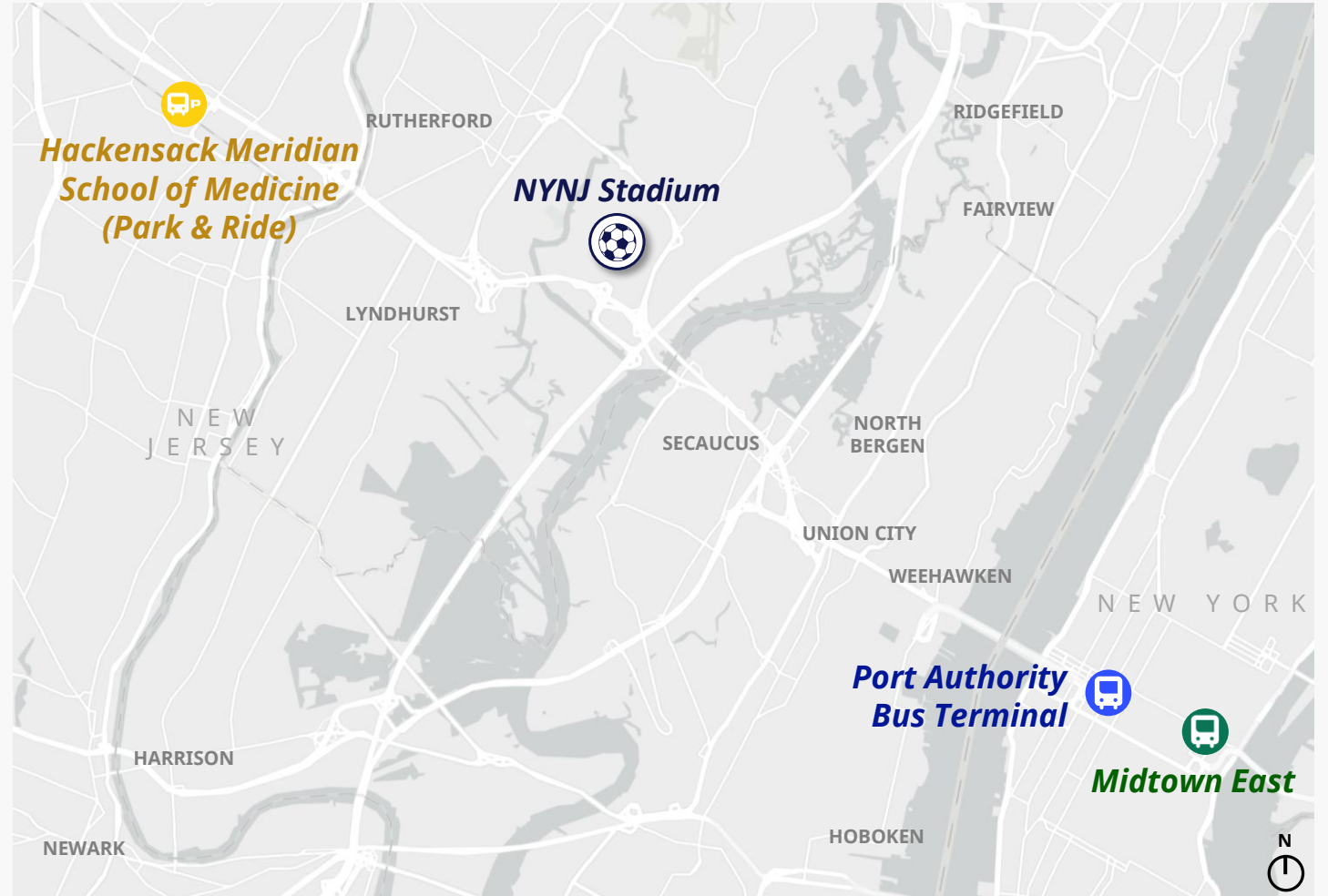


Roadway Operations

Official NYNJ Stadium Shuttle

FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY

- **Host Committee operated** shuttle service to NYNJ Stadium on match days with capacity for 10,000 spectators
- **2 locations in NYC** and **1 park-and-ride location in NJ** with direct access to the Stadium drop-off in Lot K
- Service will start **4 hours** before kickoff and continue **up to 3 hours** after the match



Shuttle Ticketing

FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY

- A **valid FIFA World Cup 2026™ match ticket will be required** to purchase transportation and to access matchday services. Transportation tickets are non-transferable and will be checked prior to boarding.
- Stadium Shuttle tickets will be available through the NYNJ Host Committee website only
- Shuttle tickets go on sale on **April 17th for \$80 per person**, and all tickets are round-trip, nontransferable, and nonrefundable
- Customers must select a **departure shuttle time window** upon purchase to help support a smooth pre-match experience
- A wheelchair **accessible shuttle service** is available for purchase from all pick-up and drop-off locations

Rideshare and Private Vehicles

FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY

- Rideshare will be available on matchdays as a **limited, supplemental option**
- All rideshare will use a designated drop-off and pick-up location at **Meadowlands Racing & Entertainment**, enabled through geofencing
- A pedestrian path will be designated for rideshare passengers to safely traverse Stadium property
- Fans should plan extra travel time, as traffic conditions are expected to be heavy close to kickoff
- If fans choose to self-organize transportation, vehicle access to the Stadium is limited to **FIFA-permitted vehicles** only
 - Without a permit, drop-off and pick-up may occur only at Meadowlands Racing & Entertainment



Roadway Operations

FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY

- Heavy traffic is expected on **key corridors** before and after matches, including streets in Midtown Manhattan, the Lincoln Tunnel, Route 495, Route 3, and the New Jersey Turnpike
- Travelers are encouraged to **avoid unnecessary trips** on these corridors during **peak match periods**, and to retime or reroute journeys where possible
- Traffic conditions are expected to be most impacted **closer to kickoff** and immediately following each match
- There has been extensive planning and coordination to manage matchday roadway operations



Travel Demand Management (TDM)

Travel Demand Management

FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY

Strong, coordinated Travel Demand Management (TDM) is essential to realizing the NYNJ Stadium Mobility Plan. Influencing the travel of ticket holders and non-World Cup demand behavior is essential to preserving reliability of the transportation network.

COORDINATED REGIONAL CAMPAIGN

Unified TDM communications across city and state agencies, transit operators, the NYNJ Host Committee, and FIFA

POLITICAL & EXECUTIVE LEADERSHIP

Escalated communications from the political and agency leadership to support the retiming and rerouting messaging on matchdays.

DIRECT TO FAN COMMUNICATIONS

Detailed, accurate communications through FIFA and NYNJ Host Committee channels on mode selection and matchday preparedness.

EXISTING COMMUNICATIONS NETWORKS

Coordination with tourism partners, business and community organizations, and other key stakeholders to equip partners with clear guidance.

What Fans Should Expect

What Fans Should Expect

FOR OFFICIAL USE ONLY

Travel on eight matchdays will look different than a typical day. Fans should plan ahead, purchase transportation early, arrive early, and follow official channels for real-time updates and guidance.

- **Public transportation** will be the easiest way to get to NYNJ Stadium on matchdays
- NJ TRANSIT and Official NYNJ Stadium Shuttle tickets are round-trip, nontransferable, nonrefundable, and for **FIFA World Cup 2026™ match ticket holders only. Only 40,000 NJ TRANSIT tickets will be sold per game.**
- Be prepared to **arrive early if you are taking rideshare or parking at American Dream** as traffic conditions are expected to be heavier closer to kickoff
- **Plan ahead, plan for extra time**, and follow official information channels to stay up-to-date on travel guidance
